**OASIS: Dian Fossey's Mountain Gorillas: Up Close & Personal 11/05, 1:30-3:30 pm.** In the Virunga Mountains on the border of Uganda, Rwanda and the Democratic Republic of the Congo, live approximately 350 Mountain Gorillas. These are the gorillas that were studied by Dian Fossey and immortalized in the movie, 'Gorillas in the Mist,' Today, 20 years after Fossey's murder, the Mountain Gorilla is thriving; they have become an icon of conservation due to an educational program started by Fossey. About a decade ago, about the same number of Mountain Gorillas were discovered to the north of the Virungas in Uganda in the 'Impenetrable Forest.' Join Art Cooley and Bev Grant who joined a group that visited both groups of gorillas. You will view and discuss a narrated video created by Terry Tucker.
